Since 2009, First District Supervisor Bob Buster has been honoring council members and their efforts through a scholarship award. Supervisor Buster and staff recognize the commitment it takes to serve on the council and make time for council meetings, community service and Youth Commission events. Therefore this scholarship award is designed to reward your hard work, assist your education and improve your community. All council members are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

Eligibility considerations are as follows:

- Graduating seniors, attending college (proof of acceptance required)
- Total number of hours you have contributed to the council?
- How many years have you served as a member?
- Have you demonstrated any improvement?
- What sort of ideas or projects have you contributed to on the council?
- Provision of Official Transcript
- Two letters of reference (only school personnel will be considered i.e. academic counselor, teacher or club coordinator)

In addition to these considerations, you are required to submit a typed, 1,000 words, 12 point and Times New Roman font explaining **why you feel that you deserve this award.**

- Explain how this award can further your education and improvement to your community
- Highlight future educational goals and how your participation with the council has shaped or solidified them
- Describe how serving your community has changed or had an effect on you
- Elaborate how you have grown from serving your community either from a student or individual perspective

ALL ITEMS are due Tuesday, May 10th. At least two staff members from First District will be reviewing your essay. Recipients will be notified at the end of the year banquet.
